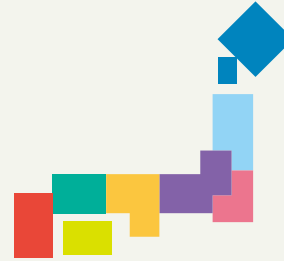

JICAの経験(道路交通安全分野での主な協力実績)

Kenya: Technical Cooperation Projects (in planning)

- ・C/P機関 : ケニア国家警察、国道公社等
- ・歩行者の交通事故死者数が多いのが特徴。エビデンスベースの取締り計画・取締り技術の移転、他ステークホルダーを巻き込んだ交通安全対策を実施。

Uzbekistan: Individual Experts

2023年協力開始。交通事故情報の収集・分析、広報活動を実施。

Nepal: Dispatch of Overseas Cooperation (Volunteers)

日本より警察OB等のシニアボランティアを継続的に派遣し、カトマンズ首都圏交通警察局(カトマンズ)にて、交通安全活動の支援。

Thailand: Technical Cooperation Projects (2020-2024)

- ・C/P機関 : 運輸省、タイ国国家警察
- ・自動車交通量の増加によって交通事故が多発しており、交通事故死者数の多さは、世界的に見ても上位。交通安全事故分析を実施し、事故多発地域の改善を支援。

Cambodia: Technical Cooperation Projects (2021-2025)

- ・C/P機関 : 公共事業運輸省、保健省等
- ・経済成長が見込まれる中、国道5号線をはじめとする幹線道路における道路交通安全に関する対策を実施。



安全運転自己診断の実施状況

Vietnam: Technical Cooperation Projects, Loan Assistance

2006年～2009年(ハノイ交通安全人材育成)。2010年～2013年(交通警察官研修強化)。2014完成: ベトナム北部国道交通安全強化事業。交通規制、取締り、交通管理等の能力向上に寄与。登録台数の増加にも関わらず多くの省において死者数は減少。(例)ハノイ市では約3割減。

Côte d'Ivoire: Grant Aid

2019年完成: アビジャン交差点改良。立体交差の双方向化による交通容量の更なる増強により、交差点の安全性の向上に寄与。

Ghana: Grant Aid

2020年完成: テマ交差点立体化。朝夕は通勤交通等により渋滞。交差点立体化により交通の利便性及び安全性の向上に寄与。

Tanzania: Loan Assistance

2020年事業開始: アルーシャ-ホリリ間道路改修事業。4車線化により歩行者・自転車・自動車交通の安全性向上。

Tanzania: Grant Aid

2017年完成: ダルエスサラーム交差点改良。交差点内で発生していた接触事故等が大幅に減少し、交通安全の向上が図られることが期待。

Bangladesh: Technical Cooperation Projects (2021-2025)

- ・C/P機関 : ダッカ首都警察
- ・交通安全教育・交通安全事故収集に係る支援やパイロット事業などを行い、これら一連の活動を通じてダッカ首都警察の道路交通安全対策能力向上を実施。

Training Courses (Global)

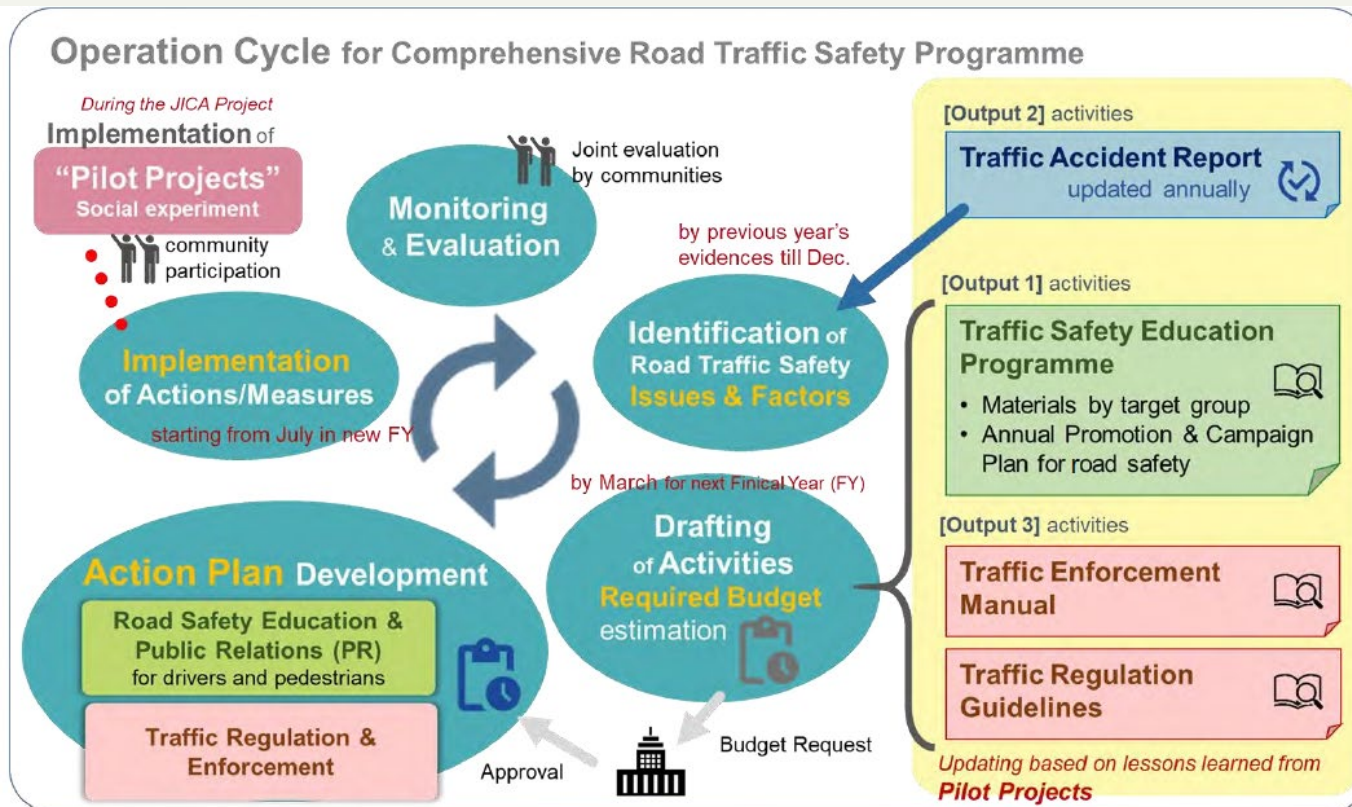

来日による研修状況

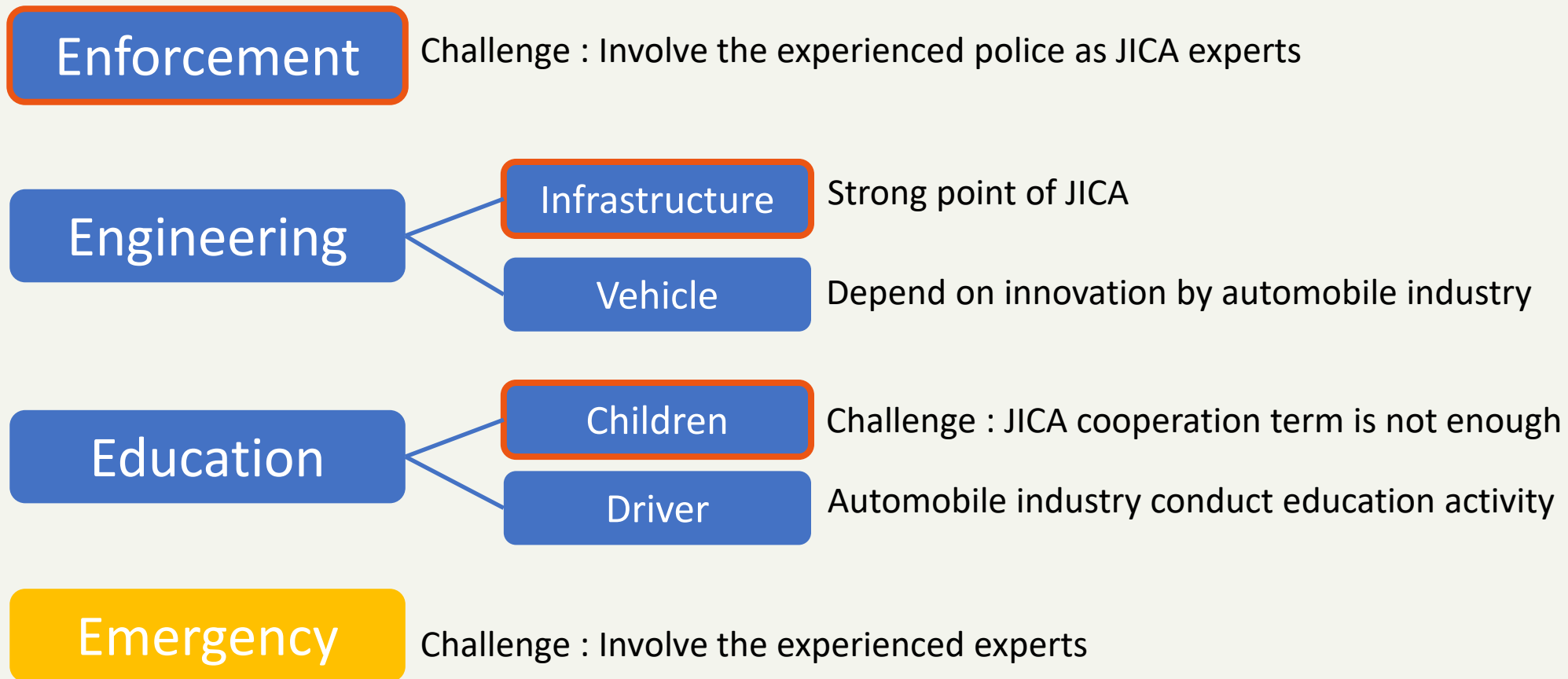
